### Annual Evidence Updates - Sexual Health

To coincide with World Aids Day on 1st December, we have just launched the second Annual Evidence Update on *HIV/AIDS - Behaviour change in high-risk populations*. Available from 30th November, this year's update has identified 32 systematic reviews, meta-analyses, and literature reviews. Additionally a number of UK and international guidance to support HIV/AIDS have been identified. This evidence update focusses on sexual health interventions targeting behaviour change in high-risk populations including ethnic minorities, gay men, injecting drug users, young people, commercial sex workers, and other populations at high-risk of infection. It complements the Annual Evidence Update (AEU) published by [NHS Evidence - infections on maternal & child transmission of HIV](#).
