



QUESTIONS FOR WORKSHOP DISCUSSION

The NAPS NCIS Working Group would like the workshop participants' views in relation to the following: -

1. Proposed data standards:
 - a. Are they clear?
 - b. Will they be useful?
 - c. Are any modifications needed?
 - d. Are they compatible with/acceptable to other important reference collections?
2. Proposed list of variables:
 - a. Are there any variables to be deleted? Are there any other variables to be added?
3. Issues for data collection:
 - a. Is it feasible to collect the desired information in the proposed settings – CHAIR, CRIS, and Heartwatch?
 - b. Are any modifications needed?
 - c. What other issues regarding data collection in the patient care settings should be considered?
4. Education and training:
 - a. Is it feasible to incorporate the education and training suggestions into existing education and training activities in CHAIR, CRIS, and Heartwatch?
5. Any other comments?

It is suggested that at least 30 minutes be spent on questions 1 and 2 on the data standards and 20 minutes on the remaining questions.
