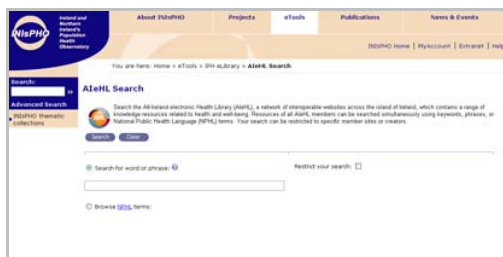



What is the AleHL?

The All-Ireland electronic Health Library (AleHL) is an initiative of Ireland and Northern Ireland's Population Health Observatory (INISPHO). AleHL is a network of "interoperable" websites that can be searched simultaneously. Each website contains different types of knowledge resources related to health and well-being including policy and strategy documents, data (numerical and non-numerical), research and evaluation reports, other media, project details, contacts and websites.



The AleHL supports effective decision-making by helping people to more easily bring together knowledge resources that are distributed across many different websites.

Accessing the library

The AleHL can be accessed by logging onto www.inispho.org and clicking on the AleHL logo .

Ever had to endlessly search numerous websites to locate that information?

The All-Ireland electronic Health Library (AleHL) can help you.

How does the Library work?

All the resources held by the member websites are "tagged" using the same agreed metadata. This metadata incorporates National Public Health Language (NPHL) terms and the Public Health Resource Type Encoding System (PHRTES). This metadata tagging allows

all member websites to be searched in a consistent manner at the same time.

When you search the AleHL from a member website you can either search only that website, or expand your search to include all or any of the other member websites. You can search using either keywords and phrases, or using NPHL terms.

Benefits of the library

The AleHL

- allows users to retrieve different types of knowledge resources in an effective and efficient manner;



- facilities more effective sharing and integration of knowledge; and
- provides the basis for the rational management of the resources on its member websites.
