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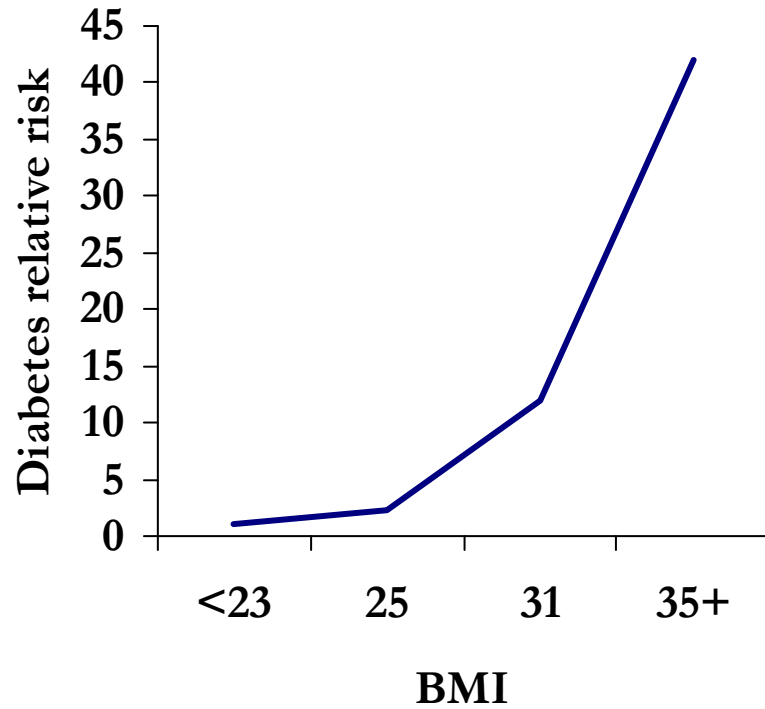
- 10% health budget
 - 60% to treat complications
- €70 million to implement strategy (DFI)
- Prevalence will increase 30-60% in the next 20 years
- Global prevalence 5.1%
 - 1985 30m
 - 2000 177m
 - 2030 366m

Diabetes

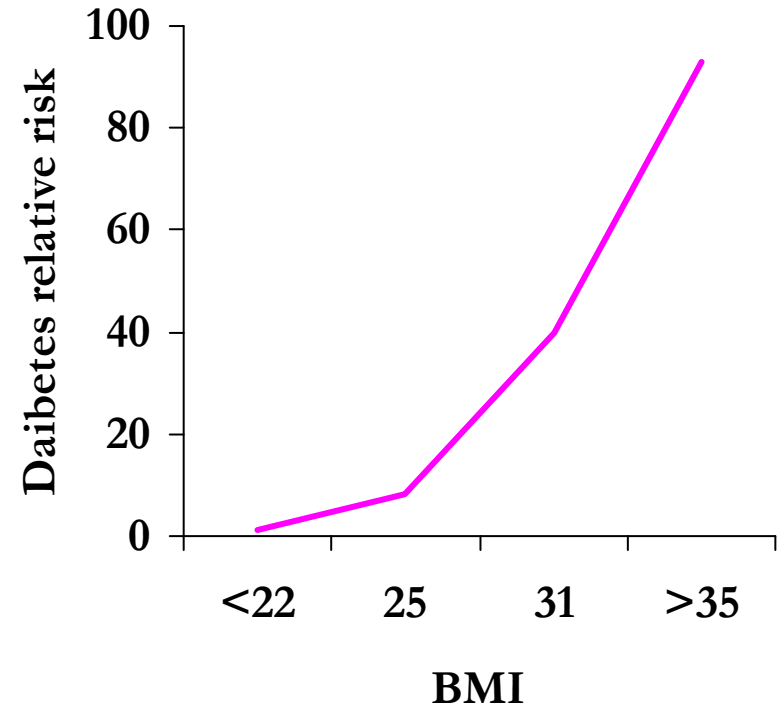
- 80% of premature diabetes preventable
- Over 140,000 people in Ireland with diabetes
- ? 100,000 are undiagnosed
- Interventions at most stages of Type 2 diabetes are cost-effective
- Prevalence depends on obesity trends and demography
Must arrest trends in obesity and physical inactivity

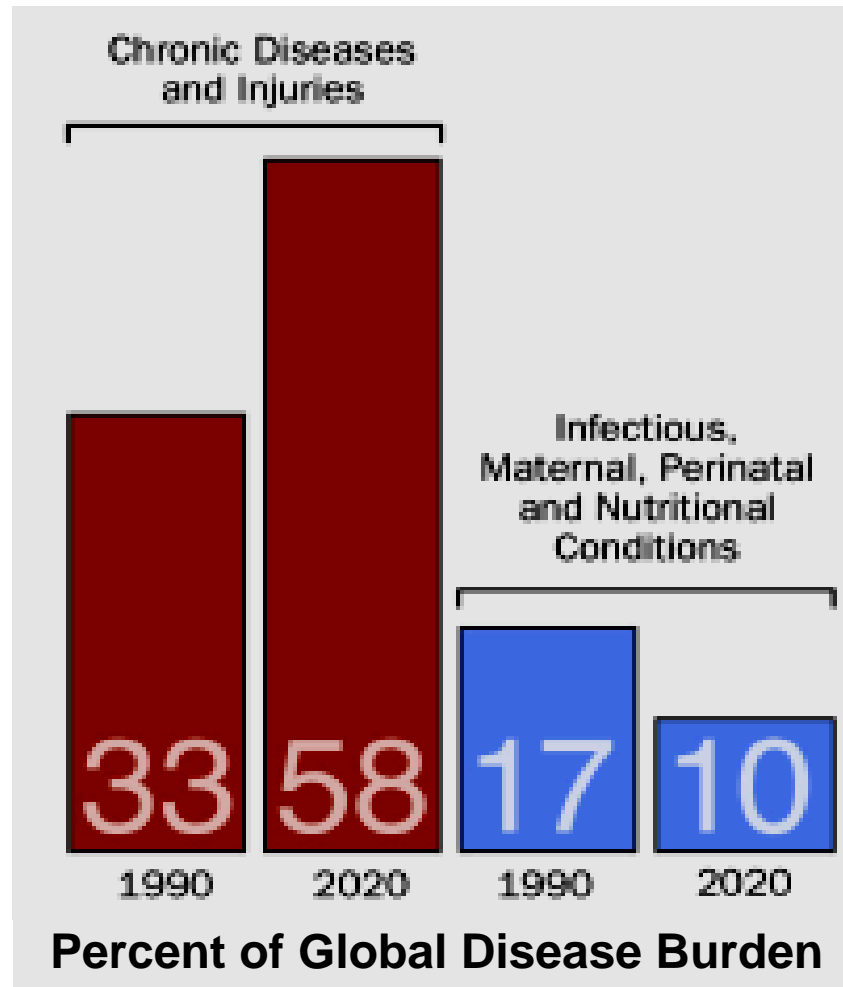

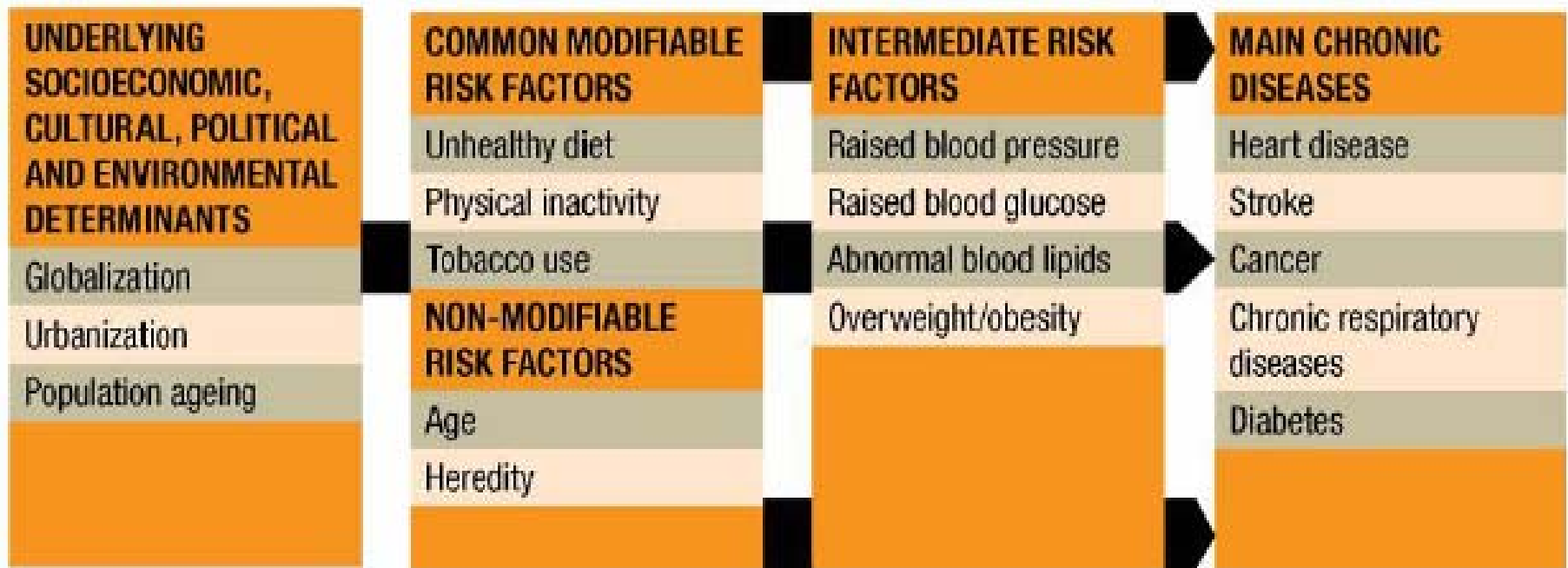
Females

Causes of chronic diseases

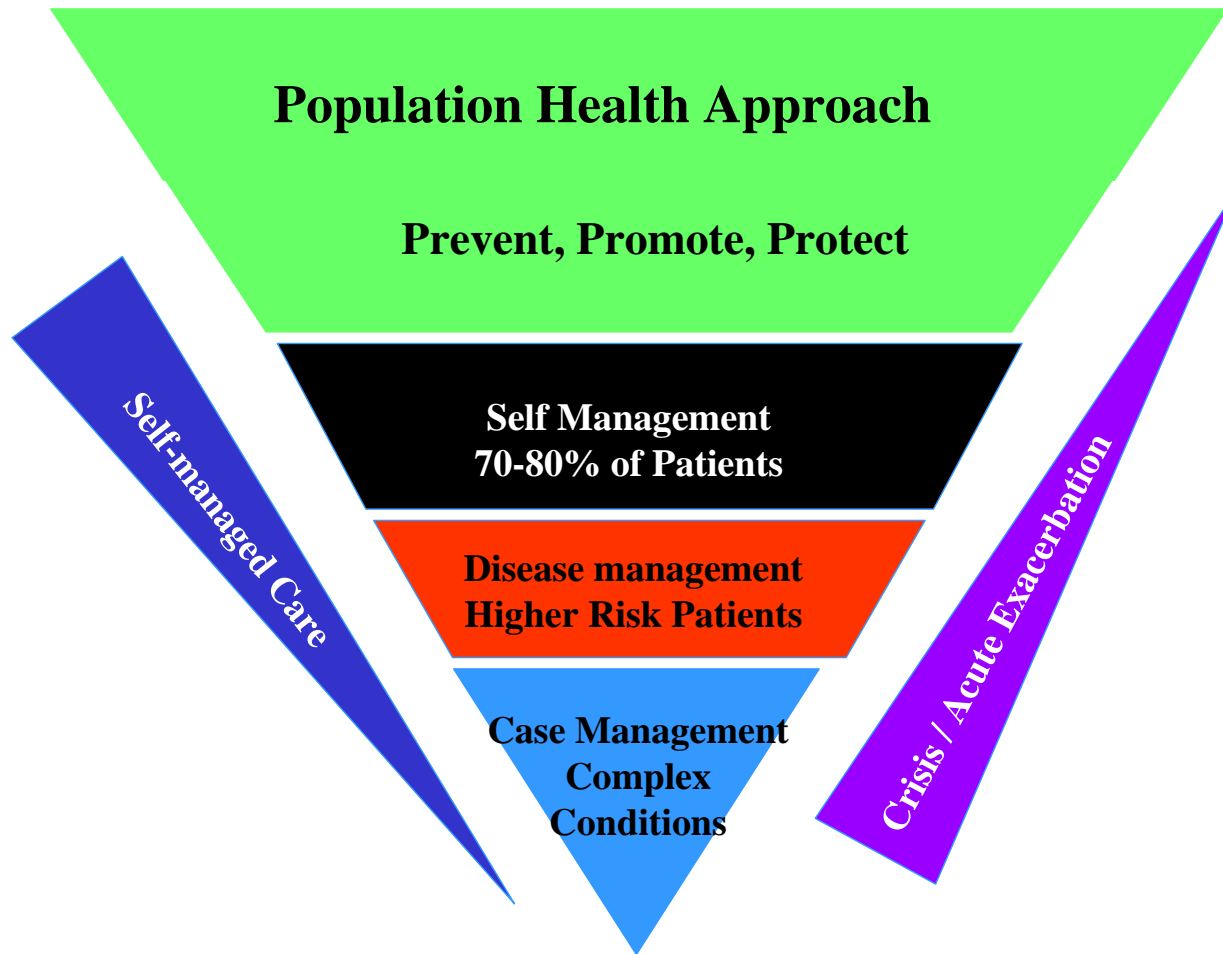


The global goal

Expert Advisory Group in Diabetes



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- Build on DOHC policy guidance
- Use a Population Health Model of Care
- Primary source of strategy advice
- Re-orientate the Health system from hospital to primary care
- Opportunity for professionals / leaders to bring expertise

Steering group- Diabetes



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- Interagency Steering Group established
- Relevant parts of HSE
- Led by Population Health
 - Examine needs nationally
 - Set priorities: register, prevention, management, guidelines, develop services –retinopathy
 - Focus on Estimates process 2007
